The Integrity Commission invites eligible candidates to submit applications for the position of **Network and Security Officer (MIS/IT 4)**.

The incumbent will report to the Systems Administrator and will be employed on a contractual basis for a period of two (2) years in the first instance.

The Network and Security Officer is responsible for deploying procedures and technologies required to assure the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of the Commission's networking and computing infrastructure.

The incumbent will be responsible, *inter alia*, for:

- Administering the organisation's Network, Servers and Communication Systems
- Securing the network and data systems within the Commission
- Providing support to the Integrity Commission's staff

The ideal candidate should be a highly motivated individual and should possess, at a minimum:

- Professional Certification in Computing/Diploma in Computer Science or its equivalent
- Two (2) or more years' experience in user/technical support;
- Keen knowledge of Linux and Windows Server implementations of the following networking protocols:
 - DNS, DHCP, LDAP, SMTP, POP
- Experience in routing and switching
- Experience with Virtual Servers/Machines
- Knowledge and experience in securing a network i.e. protocols, tools, tests
- Ability to analyze existing and future systems across the Commission, review security architectures and develop engineering solutions that integrate information security requirements to proactively protect information
- Capacity to perform audit and security compliance checks, including network penetration testing, vulnerability scans, and other configuration analysis
- Good writing and oral communication skills;
- Well-developed analytical and critical thinking skills;
- Sound character, credibility, integrity and the ability to establish confidence and respect with both internal and external stakeholders

Candidates who possess any of the following qualifications or skills will have a distinct advantage:

- A Bachelor of Science Degree in Computer Science, Information Technology or Management Information Systems
- Industry Certification such as: CISSP, CEH, CCNA, Security+, Network+, Cloud+, Server+
- Linux Server Administration, Managing networking, security, storage and user access services
- Experience with Scripting, Electronic Storage Management, Penetration Testing, Database Administration
