OFFICE OF THE CONTRACTOR GENERAL COMPLETES INVESTIGATION INTO ALLEGATIONS CONCERNING THE DIVESTMENT OF SHARES OF PETROJAM LIMITED – SUBMITS REPORT TO PARLIAMENT

Kingston, May 30, 2008 – The Office of the Contractor-General has concluded its special investigation into the allegations which were made in May 2007, by the then Leader of the Opposition and current Prime Minister, the Hon. Bruce Golding, that Petrojam’s shares were being sold below their market value.

In keeping with his statutory obligations under the Contractor General Act, copies of the Report of Investigation have been formally submitted by Contractor General, Greg Christie, to the principal officers of the three (3) Public Bodies concerned, Petrojam Limited, the Petroleum Corporation of Jamaica (PCJ) and the Ministry of Energy, and to the Minister of Government who has portfolio responsibility therefore, namely, the Hon. Clive Mullings.

“In the interest of public transparency, I have also formally conveyed copies of the Investigation Report to the Honourable Speaker of the House of Representatives and to the Honourable President of the Senate”. Mr. Christie said.

Section 28 (3) of the Contractor General Act requires the Speaker and the President to have the Reports tabled in both Houses of Parliament ‘as soon as possible’.



The Reports were formally submitted under cover of letters which were dated May 28, 2008.
